The USMS Convention is where representatives from all LMSCs come together in one location to elect USMS board members and officers, promulgate USMS rules and legislation, determine governing and operating policy, review and approve finances, select National Championships sites and develop and plan new Masters swimming programs and activities.

Our delegates from the Ozark LMSC attend various meetings and workshops all day for 3 days, assist in formulating and carrying out USMS administrative and activity programs and gather information to bring back to our members in the Ozark LMSC. We use our combined experience from the convention to better serve our members, govern the Ozark LMSC and promote fitness through Masters swimming. Our focus is to promote Masters Swimming in the Ozark LMSC region, independent of one's affiliation to any club or team.

### **Thinking about LC Nationals in Indianapolis August 6-10, 2009?**

Entry information for the 2009 LC Nationals is in the latest USMS Swimmer magazine and online at <http://www.usms.org/comp/lcnats09/>

Please note that the deadline to enter at the cheapest rate is online or received by June 23 (\$40 surcharge). After that it is \$50 surcharge with final deadline of July 3 (received by or online).

Don't think you can take that much time off to go to this event? You can swim three individual events in one day (total of six for the meet if you have qualifying times for at least three). Keep in mind that you can swim three events at USMS Nationals without having achieved qualifying times. Consider going for the Saturday relays and staying Friday or Sunday to swim three individual events. You must submit seed times for each individual event, but no proof of time is required. Seed times should be times you have swum within the past two years. If you have not had the opportunity to swim long course events, you can convert your short course times by adding 10%, plus at least one second per turn that you will not have in the long course events. This will still probably be a faster than realistic time, so add a few more seconds for the fatigue factor that comes with long course.

If you are interested in swimming relays, you must be a USMS registered member of that relay club (SLAM, CSPM or LOVE). Unattached cannot swim on relays. Your USMS membership must be correct before you register for the competition. You can swim up to four relays on Saturday, August 8<sup>th</sup>. Be sure to let your club president or relay coordinator know that you are interested in relays.

The deadline for entries to be received for Nationals is July 3<sup>rd</sup>, but there are still some opportunities to swim a long course meet before then. Here are some options:
